

# LAUREN CASEY-CLYDE

**Lauren Casey-Clyde** is an International performer and private instructor residing in Austin, TX. She maintains an active performance career on both trombone and euphonium, that has brought her across the globe. She has had the opportunity to perform with such as The Boston Symphony Orchestra, with conductors Andris Nelsons and Bernard Haitink. Lauren has been recognized at regional, national and international Solo Competitions. Most recently, she placed third in the Susan Slaughter Solo Competition at the 2019 International Women's Brass Conference. She was a finalist in the Artist Euphonium Competition of the 2018 Midwest Regional ITEA Conference in Fort Wayne, and was the Winner of the Young Artists Euphonium Competition at the 2015 Northeast Regional ITEA Conference in Ithaca, NY. She has made solo appearances with the New England Brass Band, the Saratoga High School Wind Ensemble, and the Boston University Wind Ensemble and has performed as a member of the New England Brass Band, Brookline Symphony Orchestra, the Fulham Brass Band, Gardner Street Brass Quintet, and Boss Street Brass Band, a New Orleans style funk band.

Lauren is passionate about dedicating her time to teaching music to students of all ages and skill levels. She currently teaches a private studio of trombone and euphonium students , ranging from middle school students to college students in Lake Travis ISD, Round Rock ISD, and Austin ISD. She also holds students and serves as a regular brass clinician to multiple schools in the San Francisco Bay Area. She has consistently maintained a private studio of students who have made it into TMEA Region Bands, CBDA All-State Bands and summer festivals such as the Boston University Tanglewood Institute.

In the marching arts, Lauren is a brass instructor for the seven-time DCI World Class Champion, Santa Clara Vanguard Drum & Bugle Corps. She is a proud alumnus of Carolina Crown Drum and Bugle Corps, where she marched as a lead baritone, was a featured soloist, and earned an individual accolade for being an outstanding member. In 2019, she served on the brass educational staff for the five-time DCI Open Class Champion, the Blue Devils B Drum Corps in Concord, CA. At the high school level, she is currently on staff with the 2019 BOA Grand National Champion, Vandegrift Viper High School Marching Band.

Lauren is currently pursuing her Masters of Music Degree in Trombone Performance, under the instruction of Dr. Nathaniel Brickens. She is a member of the University of Texas Wind Ensemble under the direction of Jerry Junkin, and serves as a Teaching Assistant for the Longhorn Band and Longhorn Pep Band. She previously earned her Bachelor of Music degree in Music Education and Performance at Boston University in 2018, studying Euphonium under BSO Principal Tubist Mike Roylance. During this period, she also studied Trombone Performance at the Royal College of Music under the study of Byron Fulcher and Amos Miller for a study abroad program, and continued trombone studies with Steve Lange and Don Lucas in Boston. Lauren has been published in the International Tuba Euphonium Association Journal in the 2020 summer and fall issues. She can be heard on the BBC Symphony Orchestra CD *Vaughan Williams: A London Symphony*, performing with the Royal College of Music Brass Band and on Boston University's CD *Expanding Spaces*, performing principal euphonium.
